

Oregon Opportunity Grant

Oregon's largest state-funded, need-based grant program for students planning to attend an Oregon college

How to Apply: Complete the FAFSA or ORSAA

Award Amount: Up to \$3,200 (2018 - 2019), awards are made until funds are depleted

OSAC Scholarship Programs

OSAC brings together donors to provide more than 600 scholarship programs for students

How to Apply: Complete the scholarship application and the FAFSA or ORSAA

Award Amount: Average award \$4,500

Oregon Promise Grant

State grant that provides funding for recent high school graduates and GED test graduates entering an Oregon community college within six months of graduation. Application deadlines vary based on graduation dates (visit website).

How to Apply: Complete the Oregon Promise Grant application and the FAFSA or ORSAA

Award Amount: Ranges from \$1,000 to \$3,687 (2018-2019) per year

Other State and Federal Grants

Oregon also administers several other government grants, including the Oregon Chafee Education and Training Grant, the Oregon Student Child Care Grant, and the Oregon National Guard State Tuition Assistance Grant.

How to Apply: Complete the grant application and the FAFSA

Award Amount: Varies, depending on grant program

OREGON STUDENT AID APPLICATION (ORSAA)

The ORSAA is the State of Oregon's alternative to the FAFSA for Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) students and other undocumented students. These students are not eligible for federal aid. However, they may be eligible for the Oregon Opportunity Grant, Oregon Promise Grant, a variety of OSAC scholarships. The ORSAA is available at OregonStudentAid.gov. The ORSAA opens October 1 each year, eligible students should file as soon as possible after October 1.
