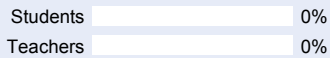

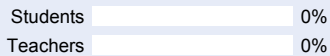

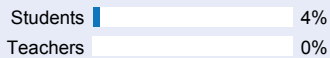

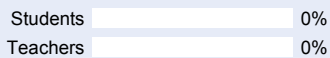

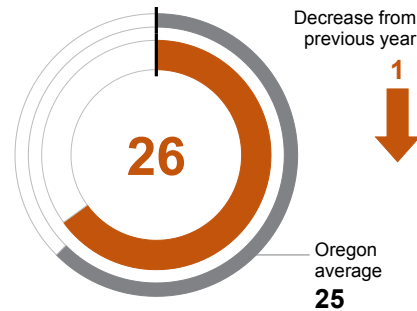

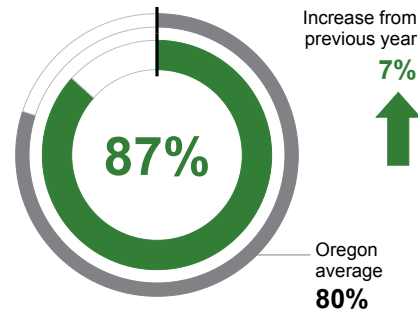
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

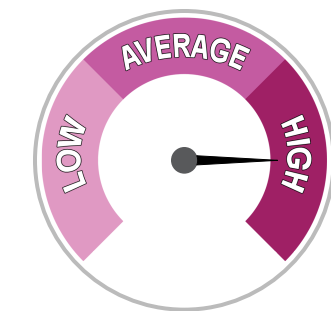
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

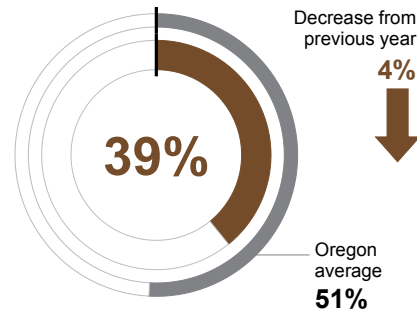
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

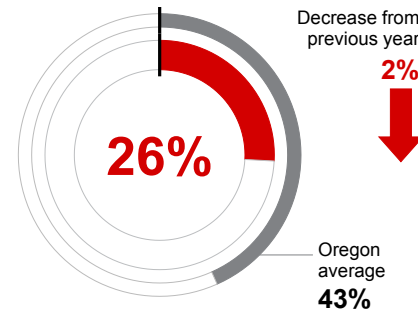
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

School Goals

Talent Elementary will continue to utilize the district-wide attendance initiatives put in place to improve student attendance. We will maintain our focus on relationships, engaging learning environment, and communication with families, which showed strong gains last year in our regular attender's percentage. Targeting Reading readiness and math aptitude by 3rd grade remain a priority for our school.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Talent Elementary utilizes several events and programs to create a safe and welcoming environment. We have an orientation/meet and greet first day with our first through 5th grade families and students. Our kindergarten teachers do home visits with all our incoming kindergarten families. Our inclusive programs consist of a K-5 Two-Way Spanish program that highlights our Spanish community. Talent Elementary also houses the districts two elementary TLC classrooms. These classrooms serve special needs students that are an integral part of our inclusive environment.
